The following items will be needed for both remote learning and in person learning. When we return to school, students will not be able to share supplies and will need to bring their art kit to art class. It would be helpful to keep these materials in a bag or box so they don't get misplaced. When we return to in person learning, materials should be labeled with the students full name and homeroom number. - Mixed Media sketchbook 9 X 12 paper needs to be thick enough for watercolor paint
- Watercolor paint set with a brush
- Oil Pastels set Faber-Castell, Cray-Pas, or Crayola all have good sets. Not chalk pastels, oil pastels are waxy.
- Package of construction paper
- Crayons
- Colored Pencils
- Markers
- Scissors
- Glue glue stick or liquid glue, your choice
- Masking Tape
- Other useful items: tin foil, cardboard, magazines to cut up for collage, a box of loose parts like buttons, beads, pieces of ribbon, pipe cleaners, etc. that might inspire creativity.
